# The HVGS University Scholarship for Teaching

## DETAILS

***The purpose of the Scholarship is to provide an outstanding graduate of HVGS with a one year Scholarship to assist them make a smooth transition to University Study.***

Further, it provides the successful scholar with a partnership with a leading independent school, renowned for excellence in teaching and learning and an opportunity to gain valuable professional experience that will assist their development as an outstanding teacher.

**The value of the Scholarship is \$5,000.** The Scholarship is tax free and will be paid in three instalments during the student's first year of University study. The first instalment being paid on 1 April with subsequent payments on 1 August and 1 October, based on the student's performance.

*To be eligible to apply for this Scholarship a student must:*

- > Have applied through UAC, or its equivalent in other states, to study Teaching at an Australian University in 2018.
- > Be able to demonstrate distinctive achievement at Stage 6.
- > Be a current pupil of HVGS, this Scholarship is only for students who will complete their HSC at HVGS in 2017.

The Teaching scholar is required to spend four weeks in the calendar year on work placement at Hunter Valley Grammar School, Norfolk Street, East Maitland. This is in addition to standard University requirements. This can be completed as a block or on an ongoing basis. Scholars are encouraged to be proactive in developing a professional relationship with Hunter Valley Grammar School.

Applicants will be interviewed in early November 2017. Students will be notified by phone and advised of dress requirements and preparation needed. The selection panel will comprise the Deputy Principal, Chair HVGS Scholarship Committee and the Dean of Innovative Curriculum.

***The Scholarship will be presented to the successful scholar at the Annual Year 12 Valedictory Dinner on Thursday 16 November, 2017 by the Board Chairman of Hunter Valley Grammar School or her representative.***

Scholarship offers are made conditional upon the scholar being offered a place in a relevant Teaching degree and subsequently taking up that offer and commencing study in 2018. A letter of offer will be sent to the successful scholar by 31 January of the scholarship year and must be signed and returned to the Principal, HVGS within 7 days of receipt.

Scholars are required to submit to the Dean of Innovative Curriculum, HVGS, a transcript of Semester 1, 2018 academic results no later than 7 days after the results become available.

The sponsor reserves the right not to award a Scholarship in any particular year if the quality of applications is not of a standard commensurate with the Scholarship.
